

# Sort It – Graph It

Grades K-3

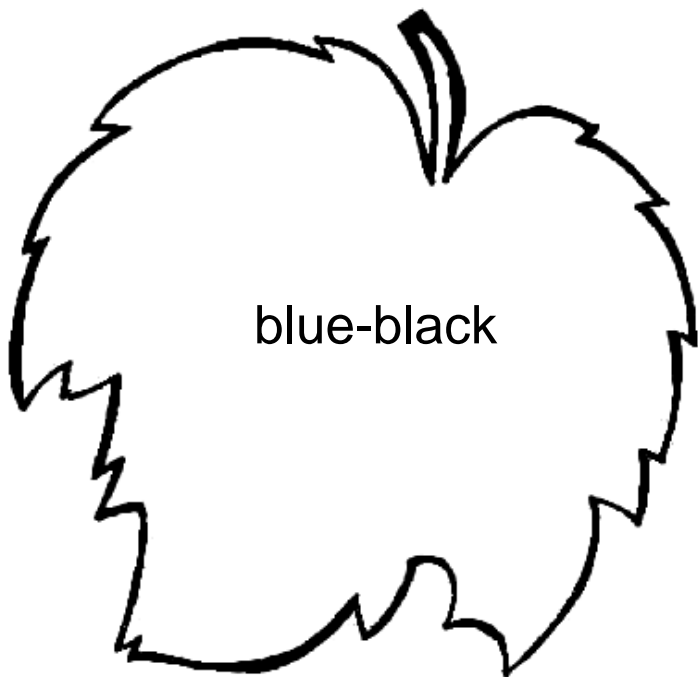
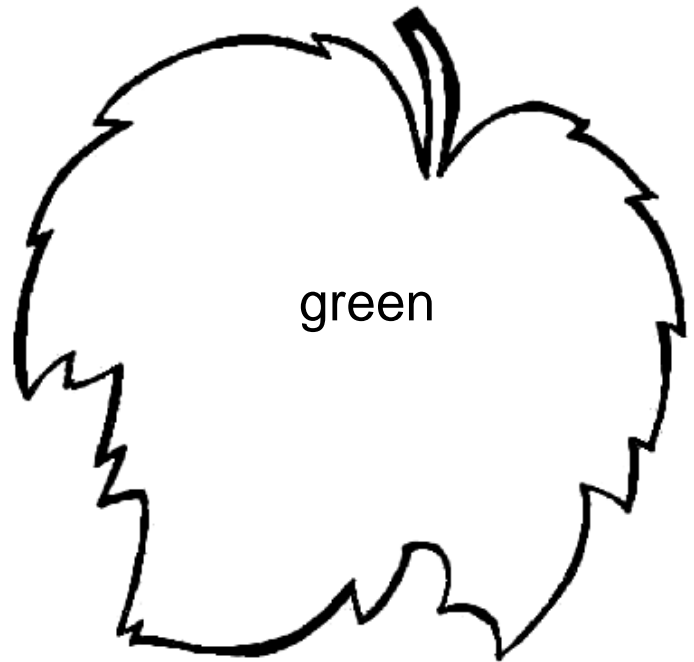
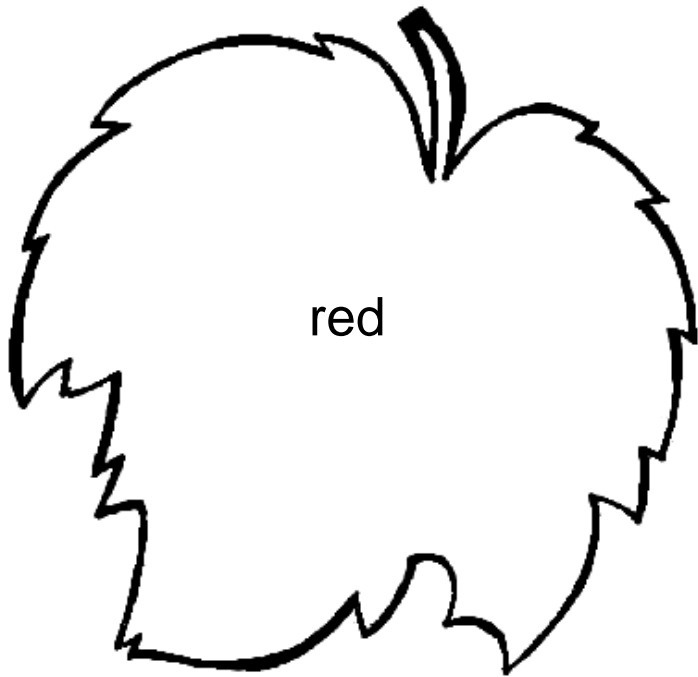
Materials	Skills Addressed
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Small plastic bags</li><li>• Three types (colors) of table grapes</li><li>• “Sort it – Graph it” sheet</li><li>• Grape graph worksheet</li><li>• Question worksheet</li></ul>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Sorting</li><li>2. Graphing</li><li>3. Number Sense</li><li>4. Addition</li></ol>

## Procedure:

1. Prior to the lesson, place a variety of grapes in plastic bags.
2. Have each student sort the grapes on the “Sort it – Graph it” worksheet.
3. Have the students count the amount of each type of grape.
4. Record the amount of grapes on the graph.
5. Using the information from the graph, answer the questions on the worksheet.
6. Let the students eat the grapes when finished.
