Five field worker scholarships were awarded in 2015: three \$20,000, four-year field worker scholarships and two \$3,500 two-year scholarships to community colleges. Also, two \$20,000 four-year agricultural scholarships were awarded in 2015.

Here are the 2015 scholarship recipients:

\$20,000 Four-year Field Worker Scholarships

Ms. Maria Torres Ramos is a graduate of Porterville High School, and will be attending University of California, Los Angeles in the fall to major in mathematics. Maria was a valedictorian and a top student in her class with a 4.0 GPA. She has the goal of becoming a teacher and creating a tutoring center. Her mother, Maria D.
