AGRICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIPS

California table grape growers seek agricultural scholarship applicants interested in building a career in the California table grape industry and in investing their undergraduate years of study in academic areas of importance to its future.

The Agricultural scholarship is a four-year \$25,000 university scholarship, available to students residing in the Coachella or San Joaquin valleys who are interested in the California table grape industry. Scholarships are available to seniors graduating in 2026 or to high school graduates, including family members of table grape growers. Three scholarships are available.

Successful applicants will major in a field of study applicable to table grapes. Examples include plant science, plant pathology, entomology, soil science, horticulture and crop science, sustainable agriculture and food systems, agricultural systems management, agricultural business, agricultural education, agricultural communications and marketing, agricultural policy, and food and nutritional sciences.

Applicants must enroll full time in a California university with a fall 2026 enrollment date and a declared major tied to a future in the California table grape industry. Preference will be given to those with interest in building a career in the California table grape industry.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- High school graduate or high school senior graduating in 2026.
- Resident of California table grape growing regions (Coachella or San Joaquin valleys).
- Planning to pursue a four-year undergraduate degree in a field of study pertinent to table grapes.
- Enrolled full time in a four-year California university in the fall of 2026.¹

APPLYING FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

To apply for the agricultural scholarship you must complete this application form, and sign and date where noted. In addition to the application form, please supply the following items:

- A statement of intent that is no more than two pages. Describe your area of study; your commitment to agriculture, specifically the Coachella and/or San Joaquin valleys; and the reasons why this makes you a good candidate for this scholarship and eventually for a career and position of leadership in the California table grape industry. Outline past experiences that have led to your interests, including community service and experiences where you displayed leadership ability.

- Two letters of recommendation written specifically for this scholarship; one from a school principal, counselor, or instructor and the other from an employer or a person in the community.
- An official high school transcript.
- A list of any honors or awards received and activities in which you are involved (e.g., school, work, church, home, or community).
- Documentation to confirm residency in the San Joaquin or Coachella valleys, which could include a driver's license, state ID card, or school ID card.

SELECTION PROCESS

Scholarship applications are reviewed by the Scholarship Committee, which is made up of agriculturalists, educators, and members of the community. The selection is based on commitment to agriculture and to the Coachella or San Joaquin valleys, academic performance, financial need, leadership ability, and community service.

The California Table Grape Commission reserves the right to not award scholarships.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

The application deadline is 5 p.m. Friday, February 6, 2026.
